Act 120 Certification Not Required to Apply

Officers are responsible for protecting the life and property of all citizens and visitors to the Municipality through the impartial enforcement of all State and Municipal laws by performing a variety of skilled operational police work, patrolling assigned locations, and responding to emergency situations. Functions with minimal supervision; must possess the ability to de-escalate conflict, stay calm, think quickly and exercise good judgment in stressful situations. Ability to communicate effectively, in person and in writing. Ability to handle inventory and evidence control, prepare reports and testify in court. Must be honest, ethical, accountable, reliable, and consistent in their work and attendance. Performs all duties as assigned and in accordance with the police policy manual.

Eligibility Requirements:

- A United States citizen.
- At least 21 years of age at the time of filing application.
- A current and valid Pennsylvania Driver's License (Class C)
- No felony or serious misdemeanor convictions.
- A diploma from an accredited high school or general equivalency diploma (GED).
- Tattoos are not permitted on the head, hands, face, or neck. Any discriminatory or offensive tattoos are prohibited.

*Complete NOTARIZED application along with non-refundable \$50.00 application fee payable by check or money order must be submitted no later than 4:00 P.M. on Wednesday, August 31, 2022. All education and Veteran's preference documentation must be presented at the time of filing application. *
